WILDFLOWER HEALTHCARE

For the past twenty-six years Wildflower Healthcare has been a critical healthcare presence in St. Johns County, offering free medical and dental services, and working with community partners to establish and build a viable healthcare safety net for the uninsured. Arising out of a need for medical care in the impoverished African American community of Lincolnville, Wildflower Healthcare became the only free clinic for low-income uninsured men and women in 1995, incorporating in 1998. For the first fifteen-years medical and dental clinics were held in local churches and the Department of Health until a community-wide collaborative funded and built the Wildflower facility debt-free in January 2010.

Today Wildflower Healthcare's eighty plus healthcare professionals, volunteers and extensive network of pro bono community partners donate their professional services to provide free health screenings, medical and dental services, vaccine clinics, and prevention/ wellness workshops to over 2,000 St. Johns County, Florida residents. The clinic is open six days a week and utilizes three state-of-the-art dental operatories and two medical exam rooms to provide healthcare services. The Outreach Team engages hard-to reach, low-income populations in the community by providing healthcare screenings and education in concert with local partners.

Vision: To be recognized as a significant and valued contributor to the health and wellbeing of the people we serve in our community.

Mission: To ensure free access to high-quality, compassionate healthcare that improves the lives of uninsured adult residents in St. Johns County.

Wildflower Healthcare is licensed by the State of Florida as a Health Care Clinic Establishment and has a Non-Profit Corporation Permit from the Florida Board of Dentistry to operate the dental clinic.




